



Emilio F. Moran is Distinguished Professor and the James H. Rudy Professor of Anthropology at Indiana University, Professor of Environmental Sciences, Adjunct Professor of Geography, Director of the Anthropological Center for Training and Research on Global Environmental Change (ACT), and co-Director of the Center for the Study of Institutions, Population and Environmental Change (CIPEC).
