

**ANNOUNCEMENT OF FACULTY POSITION**  
**Indiana University**

**POSITION:** Associate/Full Professor of Public Health (tenure eligible), with emphasis on health disparities. Director of the Center for Minority Health.  
Appointment to commence January, 2009 or earlier.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** The doctoral degree in health education, health behavior, community psychology, medicine, or a related field is required for this position with an emphasis on health disparities among underrepresented population groups. The MPH degree in a related field also is desirable. The successful candidate must have an active research record in an area specific to health disparities specifically among underrepresented population groups. A demonstrated record is necessary in acquiring grants and contracts in line with health disparities research, a strong publication record in peer reviewed journals, and a demonstrated ability to collaborate across disciplines.

**RESPONSIBILITIES:** Contribute actively to the research mission of Department and be able to procure external research funding. Direct the Center for Minority Health, an established center within the Department and School. Mentor junior faculty members. Teach courses related to the candidates expertise. Serve on departmental, school, and university committees. Remain actively involved in professional organizations and other activities of national prominence.

**SALARY:** Highly competitive and commensurate with experience.
