| Tower nasals              | Straight gonial angle               |
| Large nasal spine         | Round external auditory meatus      |
| Deep nasal sill           | Oval window visible                 |
| Retreating zygomatics     | Bulging palatine suture             |
| Canine fossae             | S shaped zygomaticomaxillary suture |
