**MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF MOTION FOR DISCOVERY
OF MATERIALS RELATED TO PROPER RECORDS**

INTRODUCTION

Election Coordinator Derek Molter has indicated in the Commission's opinion docketed 05-01 that official records exist that show specifically that Section 403 was removed from the IUSA Constitution.

Currently, the only records available to the petitioners are those available to the public via the IUSA website. Specifically, that Congress Resolution #IUSA56-R22 does not contain the approved text of the Election Code used as the basis for the Commissions decisions. Further, all records of the IUSA Congress are public.

CONCLUSION

The petitioners are entitled to the information that the Commission references in their decision in order that they mount a proper response.

This Court should grant this motion and order the Commission produce the records to which the Election Coordinator refers.
