Bloomington, IN – Pursuant to Indiana University Student Association Elections Code, Title I, Section 103, the Student Body Supreme Court of Indiana University, by majority vote, certified the 2009 Indiana University Student Association election results today. There were 7742 ballots cast in this year's election. The Btown ticket received the majority vote and will serve as the 2009-2010 IUSA executives. Peter Servaas will be the 2009-2010 Student Body President.
