**Resolution to Appoint The Chief Justice of the  
Student Body Supreme Court of Indiana University**

- 1 WHEREAS, The Student Body Supreme Court fulfills important constitutional duties  
2 in an effort to further the goals and ideals of the Indiana University Student  
3 Association;

- 5 WHEREAS, Chief Justice Brian Clifford, after five-and-a-half years of service to the Indiana  
6 University Student Association and the Student Body Supreme Court of Indiana  
7 University, has resigned his position due to his upcoming graduation from the  
8 Indiana University School of Law – Bloomington;

- 10 WHEREAS, Associate Justice and External Affairs Committee Chairwoman Meghan Dwyer,  
11 the next most senior member of the Court, having served the Court and Indiana  
12 University for three years as a congressionally-approved Associate Justice of the  
13 Court, has shown herself to be a highly qualified and capable Justice and one who  
14 is prepared to lead to Court during the next two years;

- 16 WHEREAS, Brian Clifford, with consultation from the other Justices of the Court, has  
17 recommended to the Student Body President that Justice Dwyer be appointed to  
18 take his position as Chief Justice of the Court;

- 20 WHEREAS, Student Body President Betsy Henke has approved Justice Dwyer’s elevation to  
21 Chief Justice and has nominated the same to the Indiana University Student  
22 Association Congress;

- 24 WHEREAS, Pursuant to Article IV, Section 1 of the Indiana University Student Association  
25 Constitution, justices of the Student Body Supreme Court, including the Chief  
26 Justice, must be “appointed by the President and confirmed by the Congress”

- 28 **THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED**, that the **Associate Justice Meghan Dwyer** be  
29 confirmed by a majority vote of the Indiana University Student Association  
30 Congress as **The Chief Justice of the Student Body Supreme Court of Indiana**  
31 **University.**
