I.U. Supreme Court Certifies Student Government Election Results

Bloomington, IN – The Student Body Supreme Court of Indiana University certified the 2007 Indiana University Student Association election results today.

In the absence of an opposing party, the IUSA Election Commission declared Hoosier the executive winner on Feb. 18. Students then cast 908 ballots in this year's congressional elections on Feb. 27 and 28. The Court's decision certifies both the Hoosier executive ticket and the congressional winners.

Sophomore W.T. Wright, of the Hoosier ticket, will be the 2007-2008 Student Body President.

The IUSA Elections Commission received no complaints or contests from the executive ticket or from congressional candidates prior to the filing deadline. Therefore, the Court certifies these results as final.
