## **IU Supreme Court Certified Student Government Election Results**

*Bloomington, IN.* – The Student Body Supreme Court of Indiana University certified the 2005 Indiana University Election results today. Nearly 9500 students voted in this year's elections, the largest voter turn-out in recent student government history. By a slim margin, the "Vote for Pedro" executive slate defeated the "Kirkwood" executive ticket. Alexander Shortle will be the 2005-2006 Student Body President. William Leckey, Courtney Thom, and Amanda Spivey will be the Vice-President, Congressional Secretary, and Treasurer.

The IUSA Elections Commission did not receive any complaints or contestments from the election tickets; therefore, the court has certified these final results.
