## **IU Supreme Court Receives Appeal of Election Commission Decision**

*Bloomington, IN.* – The Student Body Supreme Court of Indiana University received an appeal today from the Kirkwood Election ticket. The request for judicial review contests the rejection of the ticket's complaint by the IUSA Elections Commission regarding the 2005 Indiana University Student Association elections. The Elections Commission determined that the complaint was improperly filed due to missing required deadlines, and declined to hear the matter. The Supreme Court expects to issue a decision on granting or denying a *writ of certiorari* within the next 48 hours.
