I.U. Supreme Court Certifies Student Government Election Results

Bloomington, IN – The Student Body Supreme Court of Indiana University certified the 2006 Indiana University Student Association election results today. More than 7700 students voted in this year's elections. For the executive candidates, the Hoosier election ticket was victorious. Betsy Henke will be the 2006-2007 Student Body President.

The IUSA Elections Commission did not receive any complaints or contestments from the election tickets prior the filing deadline; therefore, the court has certified these results as final.
