Who We Are/What We Do

The Commission on Personal Safety addresses issues related to the personal safety of students, faculty, staff, and visitors to the Bloomington campus. This commission was appointed by the chancellor in 1987 and is co-chaired by the Dean for Women’s Affairs and the Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs/Dean of Students.

The commission is composed of staff and faculty, as well as undergraduate, graduate, and professional students who work together to promote policies and practices that will create a safe environment for all members of the campus community.



How We Work

- Developing programs that promote prevention of sexual assault and harassment
- Coordinating efforts with IU Police Department and the Indiana Daily Student on the reporting of sexual assault
- Leading campus walks, which ensure that lighting and emergency facilities are available in needed locations
- Producing brochures and literature that contain safety information and distributing them on campus.
- Supporting and enhancing the work of the Safety Escort, the IU Student Association, Health and Safety, the Protective Order Project and other safety organizations on campus.
- Organizing information tables at events on campus.
- Promoting policies that encourage more safety among pedestrians, bicyclists and motorists

This work is done through four subcommittees:

- Education
- Communication and Policy
- Facilities and Services
- Bicycle Safety
