- *educated at Oxford and the University of Chicago (receiving a doctorate).*
- *economics lecturer at the University of Manchester.*
- *elected Member of Parliament for Farnworth.*
- *Labor Cooperative MP from 1970 to 1981.*
- *Social Democratic Party Chief Whip from 1981 to 1983.*
- *Director of the Institute for Security Studies of the West European Union from 1990 to 1995.*
- *a Life peer as Baron Roper, of Thorney Island in the City of Westminster since 2000.*
- *Liberal Democrat Chief Whip in the House of Lords until 2005 when appointed to the Privy Council of the United Kingdom.*

Currently, Lord Roper is Chairman of the European Union Sub-Committee on Foreign Affairs, Defense and Development Staff as well as an active member of the House of Lords, where he is Chairman of the Committee on the European Union.
