

**The Internationalization Collaborative Across Bloomington (ICAB) is seeking proposals from IUB faculty across all disciplines to become a part of a unique Faculty Learning Community for the 2013-2014 Academic Year.**

The Internationalization Collaborative Across Bloomington (ICAB) involves a collaboration between Indiana University Bloomington and Ivy Tech Bloomington to further the essential objective of designing global learning experiences for all students. Faculty from both institutions collaborate together, through a series of professional development workshops and activities, as they re-design their own existing courses to more deliberately achieve and assess international learning objectives.

Professional development is provided by the Center for the Study of Global Change (the Global Center) and the Center for Innovative Teaching and Learning (CITL). The Global Center also directs the Institute for Curriculum and Campus Internationalization (ICCI), May 19-22, 2013, which directly supports the work of this partnership. Support for ICCI and ICAB is generously provided by IU Area Study Centers.

The ICAB project clearly recognizes that internationalization involves a dialogue among faculty, staff, and administrators, and that there are many vital roles and responsibilities across our campuses. With the support and involvement of the multiple offices, centers, and units at IU and Ivy Tech, the Internationalization Collaborative Across Bloomington has far-reaching support.

All IUB faculty are encouraged to apply. A stipend of \$1500 will be provided to each participant in two equal payments [second payment will be provided when revised syllabus and portfolio is complete].

### **Requirements**

- Must be able to attend [Institute for Curriculum and Campus Internationalization \(ICCI\)](#) from May 19-22, 2013 (fee will be covered by ICAB)
- Must be able to attend all six (6) ICAB faculty meetings, three (3) per semester, during the 2013-2014 academic year.
- **Meetings will be held on the following Fridays from 1 to 3 pm: Sept. 13, Oct. 11, Nov. 8, Feb. 14, March 7, and April 11.**
- Will present at a future ICCI Poster Session after teaching a revised, internationalized course.

### **Proposal Guidelines**

**Statement of interest** (500 words maximum): Please include why you are interested in internationalizing your course as well as your overall approach to teaching.

**Description of course to internationalize** (500 words maximum): Please include details of course to be re-designed, such as content, current learning goals, class size, student demographics, etc.

**Brief Letter of Support from Chair:** Please provide a brief letter of support from your department chair. This letter should demonstrate that the revised course will be taught within 1-2 academic years.
