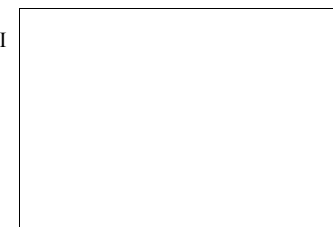
Rukajärven tie, which is also known as Ambush in English, is a war movie directed by Olli Saarela. Literally "The Road to Rukajärvi", the film debuted on January 22, 1999 in Finland, after which it was released internationally.

The movie is based on a book written by Antti Tuuri and its leads are played by Peter Franzén as Lt. Eero Perkola and Irina Björklund as Kaarina Vainikainen, Lt. Perkola's love.

Rukajärvi is a municipality (as well as a lake) in Karelia, Russia, and it was occupied by Finns during the Continuation War of 1941-44.
