The Mongolian Ger (or "Yurt" in other parts of Central Asia) is a type of housing used for nomadic peoples along the open prairies of the Central Asian Steppe. The homes are easily assembled and taken down as families move along to graze their animals. The structure of the house is made of a willow wood lattice and long poles to support the roof. The covering is typically made of felt and decorated in patterns identifying family and/or tribe. The arrangement inside the ger is efficient, though compact. Those of higher social status will always sit in the far back left of the house, furthest from the door, while those of lowest status in the household will have their bed closest to the door. These houses are remarkably warm in the winter, and in the summer, the bottoms of the felt covering are rolled up to allow cool breezes to enter the shaded area. This particular ger has a switch on the bottom which allows you to light up the interior and look inside.

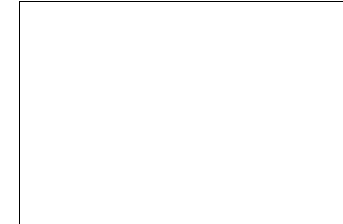

The film's leitmotif is the deli - the traditional women's costume that not only gives a distinctive color to everyday life in Mongolia but also tells something about the women wearing it by its color and the way it is fashioned. One of the most common types of deli today is that sewn for women college graduates. Eighty percent of students are women. It would seem that such a statistic would represent positive change for women. However, Urchanimeg Nansalmaa presents the accounts of people from all levels of Mongolian society to show its reverse side. After graduating from college, women have only two paths open to them: returning to the steppe, becoming housewives and marrying livestock farmers or truck-drivers or, their diplomas notwithstanding, to earn their living as unskilled workers in Eastern Asian countries.

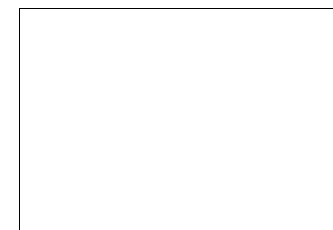
