Shot while the filmmaker was conducting ethnographic fieldwork, this documentary is about personal survival and nationalist desire in the borderlands of the former Soviet Union. It chronicles that experiences of three Uighurs who live in the Republic of Kazakhstan. In the 1950s and 60s, during the turmoil following Mao's revolution, they fled their homeland in China's Xinjiang province for a new life in the USSR. Cut off from their homeland for over 20 years, they only re-established ties with their family and friends in Xinjiang in the mid-1980s. Since the fall of the Soviet Union, they have survived by working in the tenuous trade between Kazakhstan and their homeland, China. Caught between the politics of the Soviet Union, the Republic of Kazakhstan, and China, they dream of the establishment of a Uighur state in their homeland which will allow them to determine their own fate.

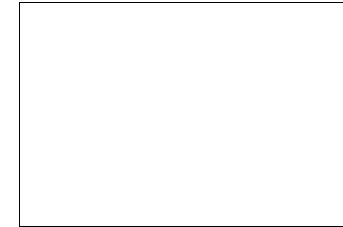

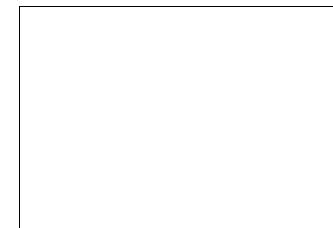

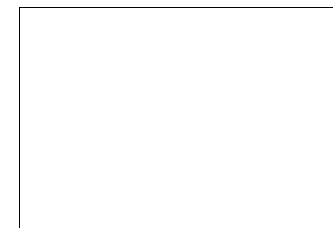
