**Items required for consideration by the Office of Admissions. Please assemble in this order:**

- This Wells Scholarship Nomination Cover Sheet (stapled to the top of the other requested materials)
- Completed Application for Admission to IU Bloomington (either online or paper application) with supporting academic documents (official high school transcript, counselor signature, SAT or ACT score results) and application fee (if applying with a paper application)
- Letter expressing an interest in being considered for nomination for the Wells Scholarship
- Personal statement describing your academic interest(s) (300-500 words)
- A letter of recommendation from one of your teachers
- An activities resume listing your most significant extracurricular activities (note any offices held), honors, and community involvement

Those students who are nominated by the Office of Admissions will be contacted by the Wells Scholars Program in early October with additional information about the selection process, and a request to submit additional items by a late October deadline.
