

Baggage/Packing

- Storage space in the caravan is limited, so it is necessary to restrict each student to:
 - one moderate size suitcase
 - a duffel bag or equivalent
 - a day pack (back pack)
- Any additional baggage or items should be mailed/shipped directly to the Field Station. Use the following address to ship or mail items:

IMPORTANT TIPS FOR PACKING YOUR GEAR

When you start packing there are some guidelines that you should follow. You should essentially have **ONLY two (2) bags PLUS a day pack**, and they should be packed as instructed below:

- ➡ 1) Bag containing **ONLY** what you will need for first week of trip.
This pertains to **ALL STUDENTS**.
You will begin the course in Rapid City, and from there will be doing field studies in areas of South Dakota, Wyoming, and Montana before actually arriving at the Field Station in Montana. You WILL need field equipment during this time (i.e. rock hammer, water bottles, boots, etc.)
This bag will be loaded into the vehicles wherever you join the caravan and will stay with the caravan throughout the first week.
You will also have your day pack with you.
- ➡ 2) This larger duffel bag should contain the remainder of what you wish to have at the Field Station for the duration of the course. **Space is extremely limited, so any excess luggage you have should be mailed ahead of time directly to the Field Station:**
