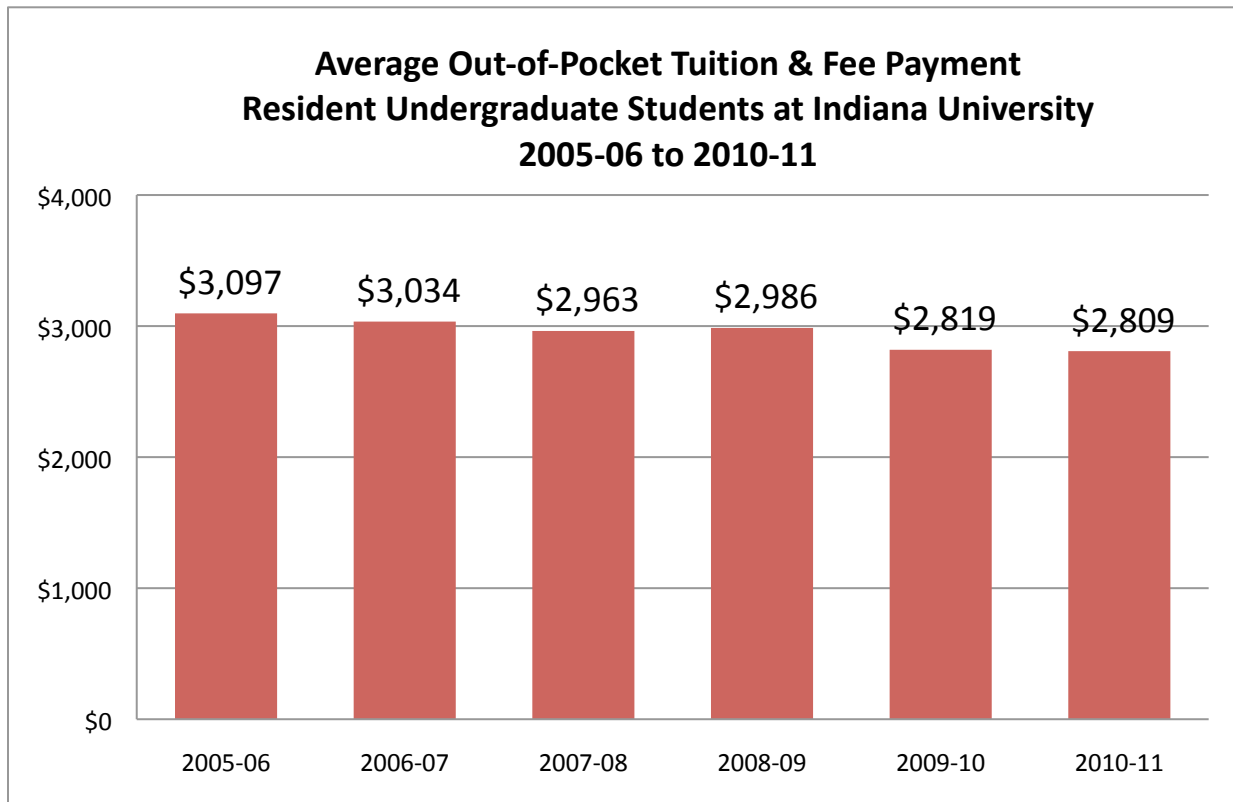


2009-10 and 2010-11 Undergraduate Tuition and Fee Recommendations Indiana University

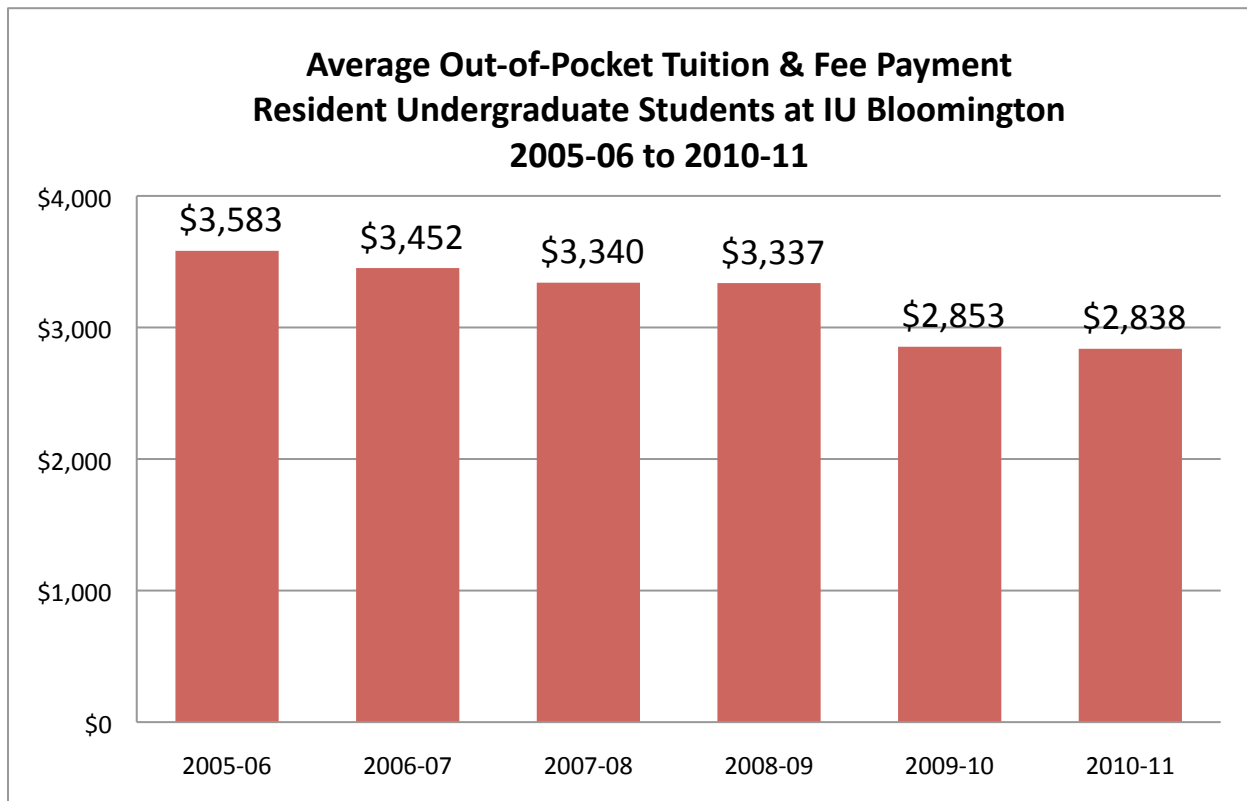
- Proposed 2009-10 and 2010-11 undergraduate tuition and fees—combined with greatly increased financial aid grants—are expected to cut out-of-pocket payments for Hoosier families by an average of 6%, from \$2,986 to \$2,809.



Bloomington 2009-10 and 2010-11 Undergraduate Fee Recommendations

<u>Mandatory Fees</u>	<u>2009-10</u>	<u>2010-11</u>
Residents:	\$8,610 (4.6% increase)	\$9,023 (4.8%)
Non-Residents:	\$26,156 (5.6%)	\$27,673 (5.8%)

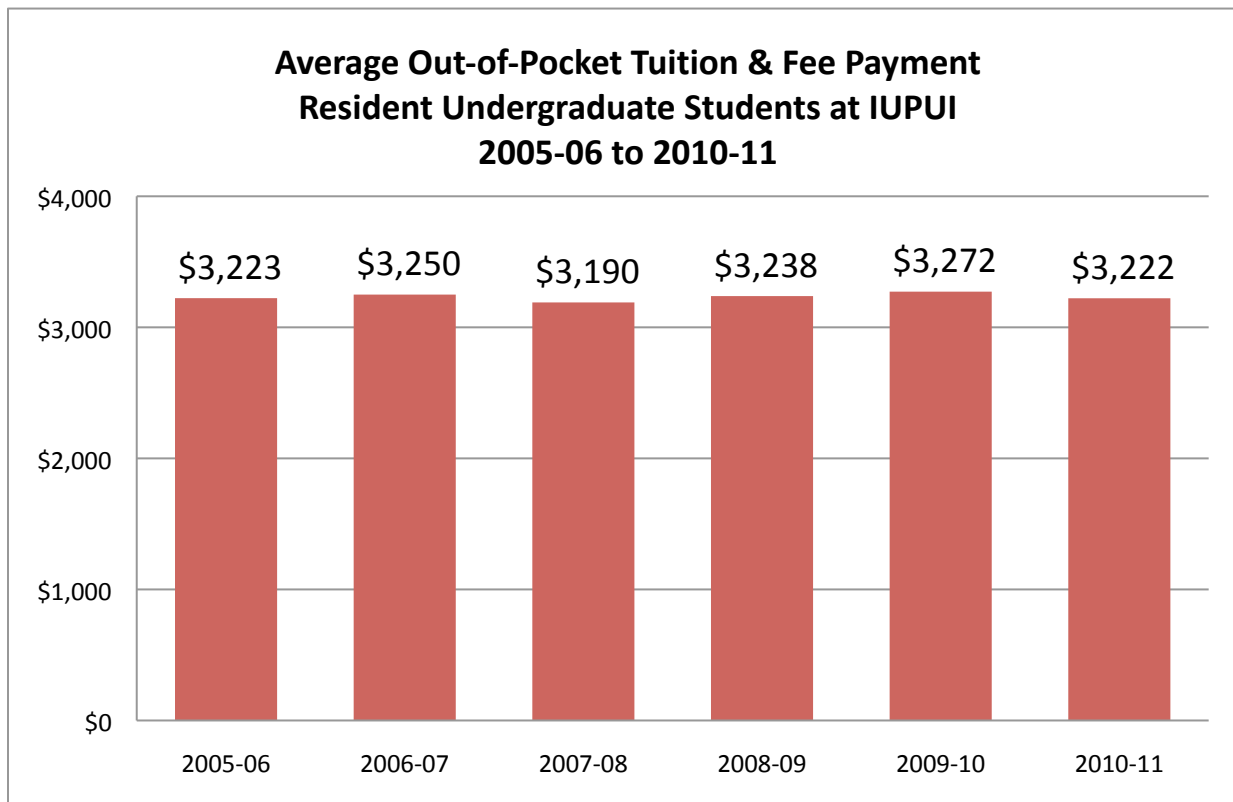
- Due to the largest increase in financial aid in IU Bloomington’s history, out-of-pocket undergraduate tuition and fee payments for Hoosier families are projected to fall by an average of 15%, from \$3,337 to \$2,838.



IUPUI 2009-10 and 2010-11 Undergraduate Fee Recommendations

<u>Mandatory Fees</u>	<u>2009-10</u>	<u>2010-11</u>
Residents:	\$7,522 (4.6% increase)	\$7,883 (4.8%)
Non-Residents:	\$22,431 (9.0%)	\$24,447 (9.0%)

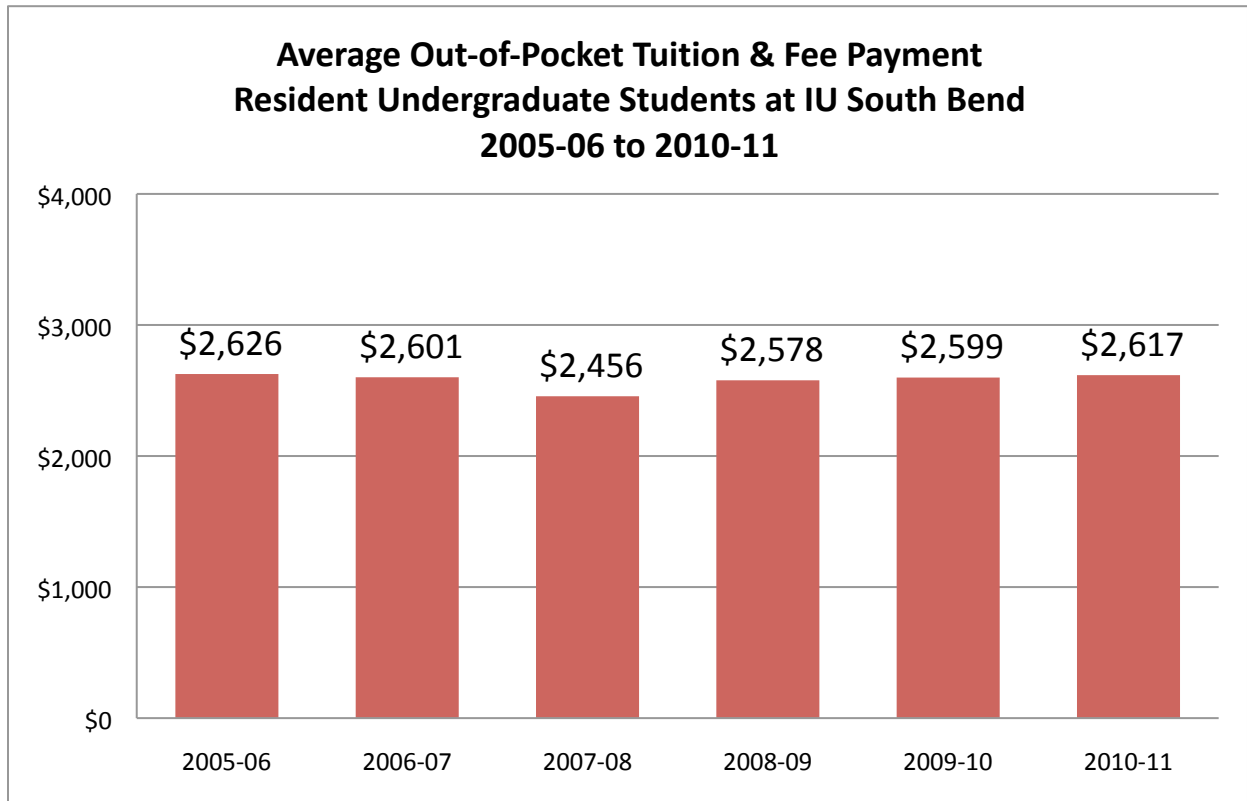
- Out-of-pocket undergraduate tuition and fee payments for Hoosiers attending IUPUI are projected to fall by an average of \$16 over the next two years.



South Bend 2009-10 and 2010-11 Undergraduate Fee Recommendations

<u>Mandatory Fees</u>	<u>2009-10</u>	<u>2010-11</u>
Residents:	\$6,017 (4.4% increase)	\$6,293 (4.6%)
Non-Residents:	\$15,713 (5.6%)	\$16,625 (5.8%)

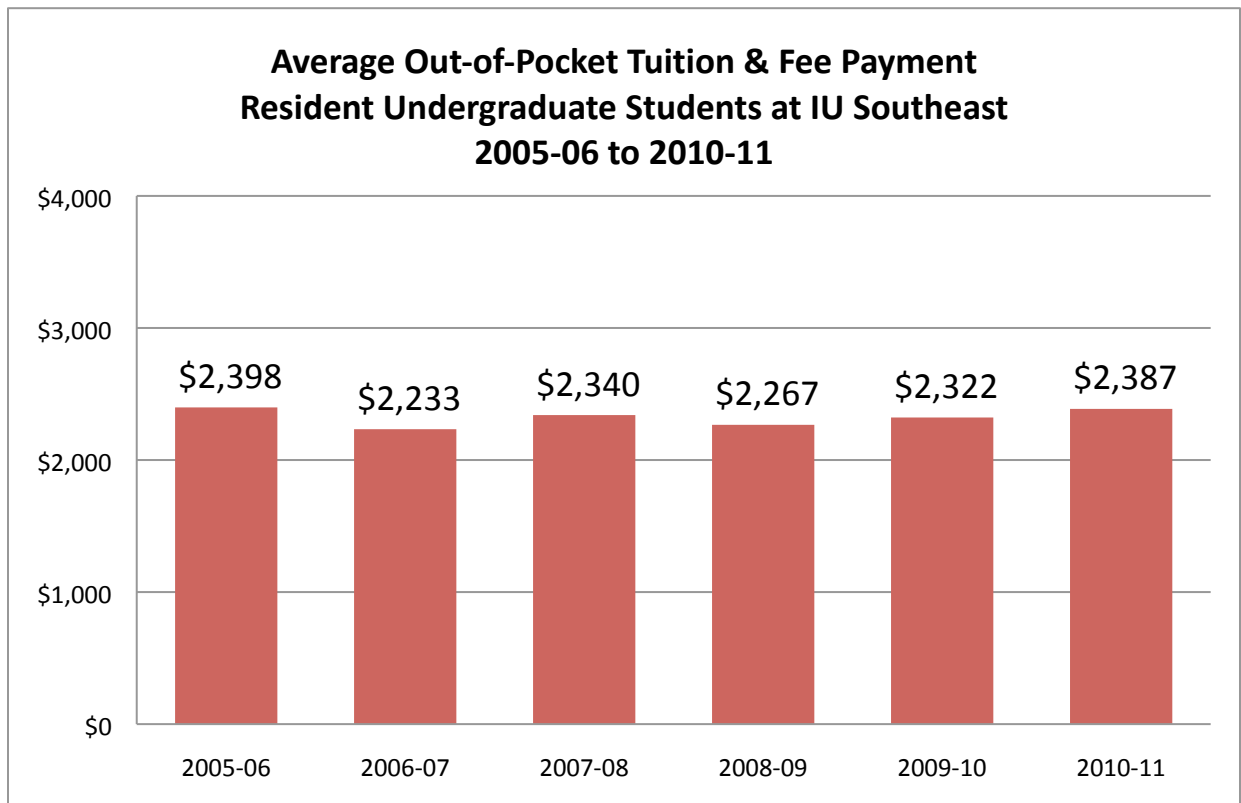
- Out-of-pocket undergraduate tuition and fee payments for Hoosier families at IU South bend are projected to increase by an average of \$39 over the next two years—to slightly more than \$2,600 per year.



Southeast 2009-10 and 2010-11 Undergraduate Fee Recommendations

Residents:	\$5,892 (4.4% increase)	\$6,163 (4.6%)
Non-Residents:	\$14,577 (5.6%)	\$15,422 (5.8%)

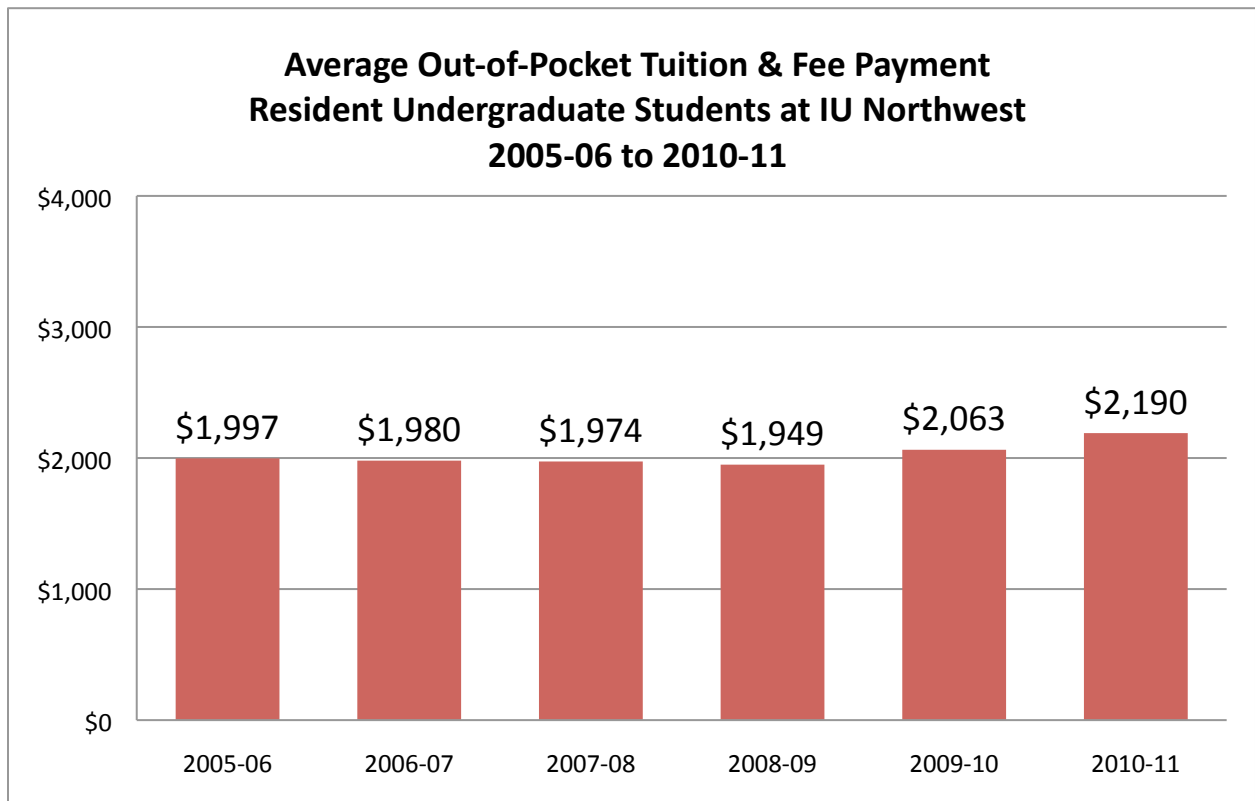
- Out-of-pocket undergraduate tuition and fee payments for Hoosier families at IU Southeast are projected to increase by an average of \$120 over the next two years, but will remain below \$2,400 per year.



Northwest 2009-10 and 2010-11 Undergraduate Fee Recommendations

Residents:	\$5,918 (4.4% increase)	\$6,169 (4.6%)
Non-Residents:	\$15,025 (9.0%)	\$16,381 (9.0%)

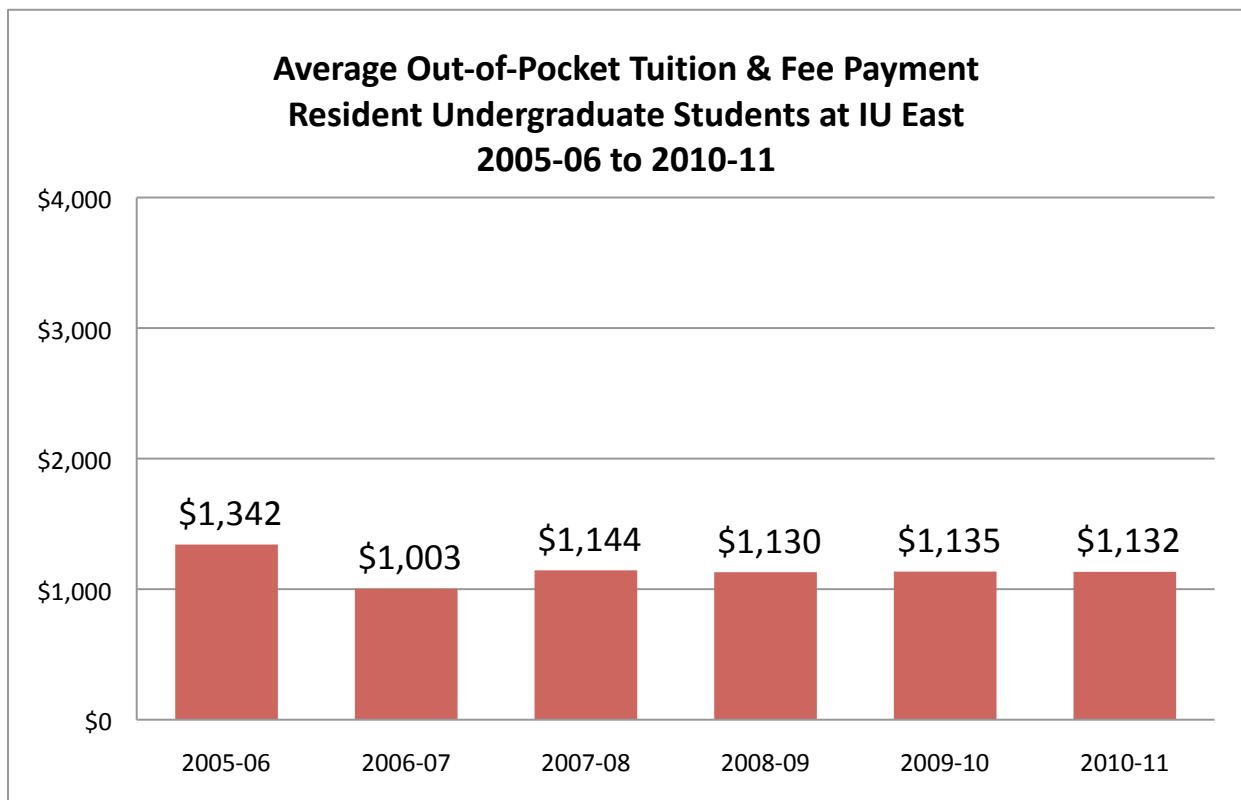
- Out-of-pocket undergraduate tuition and fee payments for Hoosier families at IU Northwest are projected to increase by an average of \$241 over the next two years, but will remain below \$2,200 per year.



East 2009-10 and 2010-11 Undergraduate Fee Recommendations

<u>Mandatory Fees</u>	<u>2009-10</u>	<u>2010-11</u>
Residents:	\$5,800 (4.4% increase)	\$6,067 (4.6%)
Non-Residents:	\$14,957 (9.0%)	\$16,305 (9.0%)

- Out-of-pocket undergraduate tuition and fee payments for Hoosiers attending IU East will remain slightly above \$1,100 per year.



Kokomo 2009-10 and 2010-11 Undergraduate Fee Recommendations

<u>Mandatory Fees</u>	<u>2009-10</u>	<u>2010-11</u>
Residents:	\$5,836 (4.4% increase)	\$6,104 (4.6%)
Non-Residents:	\$14,523 (5.6%)	\$15,366 (5.8%)

- Out-of-pocket undergraduate tuition and fee payments for Hoosiers attending IU Kokomo are projected to increase by an average of \$58 over the next two years—to slightly more than \$2,400 per year.
