- ❑ Complete EDUC Q200, EDUC W200, ENG W131, ENG W132, EDUC N343 or MATH 130/132 or MATH 136 with a C or higher
- ❑ Have a minimum 2.0 GPA in each subject area
- ❑ Complete a minimum of 57 credit hours in recommended general education coursework
- ❑ Have a minimum overall GPA of 2.5
- ❑ Pass PRAXIS I (PPST) by December 31 for Fall, September 1 for Spring
- ❑ Application deadline for Fall: Feb. 7, Spring: October 10
