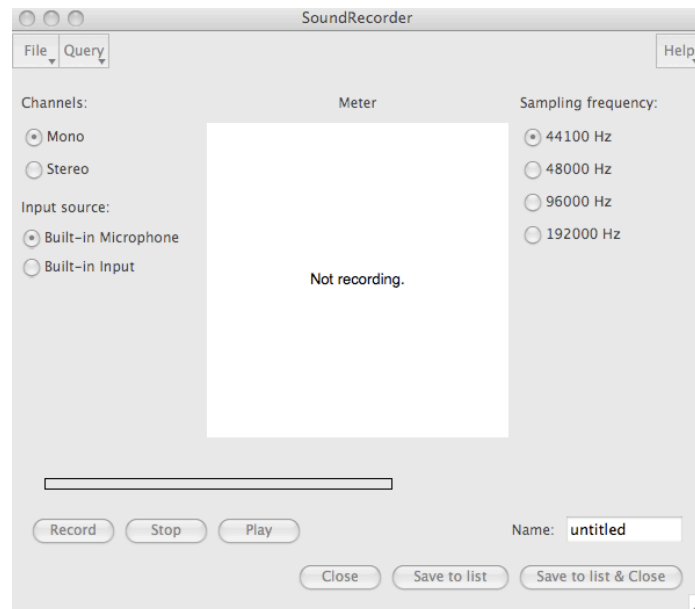


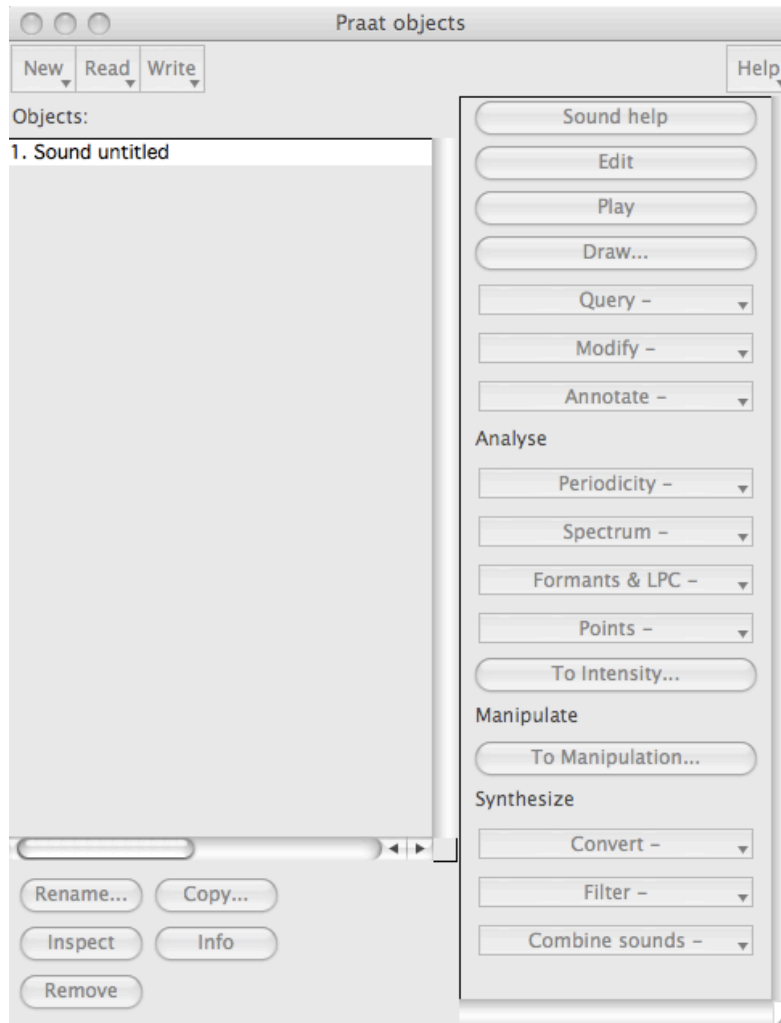
Recording in Praat

Praat can be a convenient tool for recording yourself (or others) at home or school. Make sure you have a good microphone and a quiet room. (Just a tip: Avoid most of the old buildings on campus! The heating systems, water, general creaks, etc. can be very noisy and can show up in your recordings!)

1. In the object window, go to the New menu. Choose Record mono Sound.
2. In the new window that pops up, use the Record button to start recording and Stop button to stop recording.



3. You can give your recording a name in the Name square on the bottom right side of the window.
4. To send the sound to the object window, click Save to list. The name that you have given the object will be used.
 - You can create multiple sound objects at once and save them separately to the list by pressing Save to list or you can save a single file and close the recording window by clicking on Save to list & Close.



5. Don't forget to save your recordings from the object window. New recordings will not be automatically saved as a wav file.
