Select courses as follows (16 credits in total; a combination of IES center-based courses and the required enrollment of coursework at a local Spanish university or intership)

1. (1) Required language course – Students will be placed into appropriate Spanish language course based on the results of an IES administered placement exam.
2. (4) Required area studies courses; Up to three must be taken at the IES Barcelona Center and (1) *must* be taken at a local university. Students can replace the local university course requirement with an internship at a Spanish business or organization.

**\*\*Students will be required to complete and sign a, 'Outside course Commitment' form to acknowledge the local university or internship placement requirement.**

**NOTE: Courses are taught in English, Spanish, or a combination of English and Spanish depending on placement exam – students may not take courses outside of their placement**

**NOTE: Courses available are based on student placement into Beginning, Intermediate I, Intermediate II, or Advanced track Spanish.**

NOTE: undistributed 100-level (-OS 100) courses have not yet been evaluated by a department on campus, so they do not have an IU course number. Some departments may require you to present the course materials for their review after you complete the program.

You may leave the course as -OS 100 and count the hours as elective credit toward graduation, or in some cases these courses may be used to fulfill distribution (AH, SH) requirements. This list is tentative and includes fall AND spring semester courses
