

Florence CAPA Courses and IU Equivalencies

16 credits are required for the Florence CAPA program. This list is subject to change.

NOTE: *Undistributed Overseas Study courses (-OS 100) have not yet been evaluated by a department on campus, so they do not have a specific IU equivalent. You may present the course description/syllabus to the appropriate department to have the course pre-approved for a specific IU equivalent before you go abroad. Some departments may require that you present course materials after you complete the course before the departments will grant a course equivalency. In some cases the course may count as elective credit only.*

Select 5 courses from the Language & Culture track as follows:**

- I. 1 required Italian language course (= 4 IUB credits)
- II. 4 additional courses from the CAPA offerings (3 credits each, taught in English)

Other Notes:

- **Studio Art majors need approval from the Fine Arts department for FINA equivalencies**
- Business students use the BUS-X 48* course numbers for their General Education requirements. BUS-X 485 = AH and BUS-X 486 = SH. Only business majors are eligible for BUS equivalencies.
- Successfully completing the Florence CAPA program automatically fulfills: one (1) Culture Studies-A requirement for COAS and JOUR students, or International Dimension requirement for BUS students.
