

Vienna IES Academic Program for Music Students

17 credits required for Music students.

Select courses as follows:

- I. Required IES language course (4 credits)**
 - The level of German will depend on a) previous coursework in German and b) a placement test upon arrival in Vienna.
- II. Music History (MUS-M 401/MUS-M 402: 4 credits)**
 - IU students will do a paper, in addition to the 3-credit IES music history course requirements, for MUS-M 401 or M 402 credit.
- III. Music Performance Workshop (MUS...2 credits)**
 - Required to qualify for IES subsidy for individual instruction. Involves individual instruction, ensemble work, and 2 public performances per semester.
- IV. Private Instruction (MUS...4 credits)**
 - Each IU student will contract for individualized lessons with a private teacher. Lessons may range from 5-10 during the semester, depending on how much the subsidy will cover and how much the student may be willing to pay in additional fees. Includes expected 15 hours/week of practice work.
- V. IES area Studies Course (3 credits)**
 - Each student will select one area studies course (theater, comparative literature, anthropology, art history, history, psychology, etc.) See course equivalency list or IES website at <https://www.iesabroad.org/IES/Programs/Austria/Vienna/Academics/viennaCourses.html>. Courses taught in English or German.

IU OVERSEAS STUDY ACADEMIC RULES:
