



2008 Photo Contest

Deadline for submissions: Tuesday, September 30, 2008 at 5 p.m.

Eligibility

IU students who studied abroad anytime during the 2007-2008 academic year or summer 2008 are eligible. The contest is not open to Overseas Study employees.

Requirements

Photo entries must be the original work of the entrant (*i.e., the entrant cannot be pictured in the photo*) and must have been taken outside the United States. Entries must be in digital format (in high resolution JPEG format, not downloaded from Facebook) and submitted as attachments in an email. There is a limit of 7 entries per student. If more than 7 photos are submitted, only the first 7 will be considered for the contest.

For each photo document the corresponding information must be included in the email:

- a) Title of work
- b) Complete name of photographer, e-mail address and name of program including term abroad
- c) Description of photograph, including location
- d) Names of IU students, if any, featured in the photo

PLEASE NOTE: All submissions become the property of IU's Office of Overseas Study for use in any future publications and publicity.

Awards and Recognition

1st place (\$50 in gift certificates from area restaurants and retail stores)

2nd place (\$30 in gift certificates from area restaurants and retail stores)

3rd place (\$20 in gift certificates from area restaurants and retail stores)

Winners will be notified via email. Winning entries will be posted on the Overseas Study Web site.

Criteria

Entries will be judged by representatives of the Office of Overseas Study. We will be looking for pictures that are representative of your international experience and that include students! Entries will be judged within two categories:

(1) **People:** Photos will be judged on quality and content, with special consideration given to images that depict student interaction with the host culture, students in the academic environment, local culture, and history.

(2) **Places:** Photos will be judged based on the best use of architectural, landscape, cityscape, or surrounding environmental elements of the place studied in or visited during the experience, with special consideration given to images depicting students.

The contest organizers reserve the right to disqualify entries that do not conform to the stated contest rules and criteria.
