The Overseas Study fee covers IU academic fees. In late July you will be notified by the Bloomington bursar via e-mail that your statement is available for viewing and printing from the web through their QuickPay application. The \$500 prepayment and any applicable IUB financial aid will be reflected as credits there. In order for your family to take advantage of government tax-saver benefit plans, the fees listed as "OVST fees (IU-admin program)" are the academic fees that qualify for tax-saver benefits, such as health insurance.

II. Variable Program Costs

In addition to the fixed fee paid to Indiana University, budget for the expenses below, which you will pay in Europe as you pay rent, purchase groceries, go to the movies, and travel. These figures vary from student to student, based on individual spending habits and travel plans. They are also affected by the fluctuating value of the U.S. dollar. Use them only as an approximate guide.
