**READ CAREFULLY**

1. Application Form: You must apply online at <http://www.indiana.edu/~overseas> Select Applications (at left), then IU Programs, then Venice, Italy from the Summer Programs list. Please remember that you must write a short, clear essay why you want to go to Italy and participate in this program as part of the application.
2. Letter of Recommendation: You must have a letter of recommendation from a Fine Arts faculty member or an AI. If you are not in Fine Arts, please get a recommendation from another professor familiar with your work and academic progress.
3. Images of creative work: You must submit 5 clearly labeled images of creative work on a CD Rom. Be certain everything is clearly labeled. Attach a Word document with info on CD print separately. Images should be in PhotoShop or jpg format and can be shot with a digital camera or scanned.
  - **ANY** artwork will be acceptable, particularly drawings. They do not have to be of finished work. However, please include any images of prints if you have them. If you have made artist books, you can turn these in if you do not have images of them.
  - a. We would appreciate you NOT turn in original work due to logistical problems and storage. However, if it is *impossible* to provide slides or a CD we will take a small portfolio.(All works will be returned.)
4. You must have a 3.0 out of a 4.0 cumulative GPA and at least be in your second semester at IU.
