The **CIEE fee** includes tuition, housing, orientation, cultural activities, local excursions and field trips, medical insurance, visa fees and transportation from Bangkok to Khon Kaen. The miscellaneous provider fee includes the non-instructional costs of the program. Please check the CIEE materials for any additional expenses you may incur on the program.

The **Overseas Study fee** (co-spons program) is the nonremittable portion of IU tuition, which cannot be waived if you are to receive IU credit. It is used to retire IU's construction bonds and is not retained by the Office of Overseas Study.

The **IU Service fee** underwrites the activities of the Office of Overseas Study.

In late November the Bloomington bursar will send an e-mail notifying you that your statement is available for viewing and printing from the web through their QuickPay application. Your \$500 prepayment and any IUB scholarships or loans will be listed as credits there.

If your **financial assistance** is greater than the combined IU and CIEE fees, the difference will be refunded to you. Bloomington campus students should arrange to have the refund deposited directly into a U.S. bank account (see the Bloomington Bursar website <http://bursar.indiana.edu>). If for some reason direct deposit is not an option, instruct the Bursar to mail a check to your permanent address where someone is authorized to open your mail and deposit the check into your bank account.

IU Refund Policy

Once paid, the \$200 IU Service Fee is non-refundable. The Overseas Study Fee is refunded on a cost-recoverable basis only.

CIEE Refund Policy

Students who withdraw 30 days or more prior to the program start date will forfeit the \$500 prepayment. Students who withdraw 30 days or less prior to the program start date will forfeit 25% of the CIEE program fee. Students who withdraw after the program start date will need to consult Overseas Study and CIEE. Please refer to your CIEE acceptance packet for the complete policy.
