The total fixed fee includes tuition, all housing, most meals and health insurance in Grand Cayman. In late April you will be notified by the Bloomington bursar via e-mail that your statement is available for viewing and printing from the web through their QuickPay application. The \$500 prepayment and any applicable IUB financial aid will be reflected as credits there.

In order for your family to take advantage of government tax-saver benefit plans, the total fixed fee will be expressed as two separate charges on the Bursar’s invoice. The fees listed as “OVST fees IU-Admin program” are the instructional fees that qualify as educational expenses. Those listed as “OVST miscellaneous” include the non-instructional costs of the program (housing, meals, insurance).

II. Variable program costs

Variable costs are paid in Grand Cayman as you purchase meals, snacks, postcards, gifts, and souvenirs. These costs vary somewhat from student to student depending on your spending habits.
