The IES fees include tuition, orientation, housing, some meals depending on housing choice, selected field trips and health insurance. The miscellaneous provider fee includes non-instructional costs of the program. In late July the Bloomington bursar will send an e-mail notifying you that your statement is available for viewing and printing from the web through their QuickPay application. Your \$500 prepayment and any IUB scholarships or loans will be listed as credits there.

The Overseas Study fee (co-spons) is an unremittable portion of IU tuition, which cannot be waived if you are to receive IU credit. It is used to retire IU's construction bonds and is not retained by the Overseas Study Office.

The IU Service fee underwrites the activities of the Office of Overseas Study.

If your financial assistance is greater than the combined IU fees, the difference will be refunded to you. Bloomington campus students should arrange to have their refund deposited directly into a U.S. bank account, see the Bursar website for directions. If for some reason direct deposit is not an option, instruct the Bursar to mail a check to your permanent address where someone is authorized to open your mail and deposit the check into your bank account.

Other Program Costs

Students selecting residence hall housing options will be invoiced an additional \$2,050 by IES. In addition to the fees paid to IU and IES, it is estimated you will need \$1,075-\$2,050 for meals, about \$160 for course materials and textbooks and \$2,600 for personal expenses and local transportation. These latter sums are discretionary and vary markedly from one student to another depending on your lifestyle and budget. Vacation travel is additional.

IU Refund Policy

Once paid, the \$200 IU Service Fee is non-refundable. The Overseas Study Fee is refunded on a cost-recoverable basis only.
