The IU fixed fee includes all tuition, housing, transportation and health insurance in Costa Rica, and meals during the three days at the Ecolodge San Louis and the three days at La Selva field station. You will pay for your own meals during the other days of the program.

In order for your family to take advantage of government tax-saver benefit plans, your total program fee will be expressed as two separate charges on the Bursar's invoice. The fees listed as "OVST IU-admin" are the instructional fees that qualify as educational expenses. Those listed as "OVST Miscellaneous" include all the non-instructional costs of the program, such as room, board and health insurance.

**\*\*\*\*\*Note that fees for the Costa Rica program are separate from and IN ADDITION TO the tuition you pay for Spring Semester course work in Bloomington.**

**II. Variable program costs**

In addition to the fixed fee paid to IU, you should budget \$400-\$600 for food, souvenirs and miscellaneous expenses in Costa Rica.

**IU Withdrawal and Refund Policy**

Students who withdraw from IU administered programs are responsible for non-recoverable costs. Your Bursar account will be assessed an additional charge to cover any/all amounts that Overseas Study has committed or paid on your behalf and are non-recoverable at the time of withdrawal, possibly including housing, meals, transportation, and faculty or staff compensation.
