The Overseas Study Fee includes IU tuition, orientation, and health insurance coverage while you are abroad. In late November you will be notified by the Bloomington bursar via e-mail that your statement is available for viewing and printing from the web through their QuickPay application. The \$500 prepayment and any applicable IUB financial aid will be reflected as credits there.

II. Variable Program Costs

Variable program costs are incurred abroad as you pay for food and housing, purchase snacks, textbooks and souvenirs, and travel. The costs vary from student to student, depending on your life style and travel itinerary.
