The Overseas Study fee includes tuition and medical insurance valid anywhere outside the U.S. during the dates of the program. In late November you will be notified by the Bloomington bursar via e-mail that your statement is available for viewing and printing from the web through their QuickPay application. The \$500 prepayment and any applicable IUB financial aid will be reflected as credits there.

In order for your family to take advantage of government tax-saver benefit plans, your total program fee will be expressed as two separate charges on the Bursar's invoice. The fees listed as "IU-admin" are the academic fees that qualify for tax-saver benefits. Those listed as "Miscellaneous" include all the non-academic costs of the program, such as health insurance.

II. Variable Program Costs

Variable costs include housing, meals and personal expenses. Overseas Study will forward your housing deposit (\$200-\$500 depending on the option you select) to Monterrey. In January you will pay the balance of your housing costs in Monterrey: either dorm fees to ITESM or housing fees to your Mexican host family. The ITESM dorm fee does not include a meal plan. You will need additional funds to purchase groceries, meals, and snacks, and to pay for all personal and miscellaneous expenses. These costs vary from student to student depending on your lifestyle and travel plans and the exchange rate. Use them only as an approximate guide.
