The total fixed fee includes tuition, housing, one meal daily, excursions, and health insurance valid during program dates. In late April you will be notified by the Bloomington Bursar via e-mail that your statement is available for viewing and printing from the web through OneStart. Your prepayment and any IUB financial aid will be reflected as credits there. Stafford loans will be disbursed in two payments. Please contact the Office of Financial Assistance with any questions concerning loan disbursement.

In order for your family to take advantage of government tax-saver benefit plans, the total fixed fee will be expressed as two separate charges on the Bursar’s invoice. The fees listed as “OVST fees (IU-admin program)” are the academic fees that qualify for tax-saver benefits. Those listed as “OVST miscellaneous” include the non-academic costs of the program such as housing and insurance.

II. Variable program costs

Variable costs are paid in Osaka as you pay for meals, personal expenses (snacks, public transportation, entertainment), and weekend travel. You should budget an additional \$800 for meals.

IU Withdrawal and Refund Policy

Students who withdraw from IU administered programs are responsible for non-recoverable costs. Your Bursar account will be assessed an additional charge to cover any/all amounts that Overseas Study has committed or paid on your behalf and are non-recoverable at the time of withdrawal, possibly including housing, meals, transportation, and faculty or staff compensation.
