



I. Estimated Fees Paid to The University of Western Australia (UWA) *

In late November you will be notified by the Bloomington Bursar via e-mail that your statement is available for viewing and printing from the web through their QuickPay application. Any Bloomington campus financial aid will be listed as a credit there. The Overseas Study Fee (co-spons) that you are charged is the nonremittable portion of IU tuition, which cannot be waived if you are to receive IU credit. It is used to retire IU's construction bonds and is not retained by the Office of Overseas Study. The IU Service fee underwrites the activities of the Office of Overseas Study and is non-refundable.

If your **financial assistance** is greater than the combined IU fees, the difference will be refunded to you. Bloomington campus students should arrange to have the refund deposited directly into a U.S. bank account, see the Bursar website for directions. If for some reason direct deposit is not an option, instruct the Bursar to mail a check to your permanent address where someone is authorized to open your mail and deposit the check into your bank account. ***It is your responsibility to send your payment to UWA. IU will not send payments to UWA on behalf of the students.***

III. Variable Program Costs in US Dollars

Variable costs include your visa fee, room and board charges paid in Perth, personal expenses and textbooks, and vacation travel. These costs vary significantly from student to student because they are based on individual spending habits and lifestyle. They are also affected by the exchange rate of the dollar. Use these figures only as an approximate guide.

To estimate the total cost of study abroad for **you**, add the UWA fees and the payment to IU to the **lower** end of the variable cost range if you know how to manage on a smaller budget, or to the **higher** end of the range if you plan extensive travel and want considerable freedom to purchase clothing and eat out.
