



I. Fees Paid to College Year in Athens*

Due 3 weeks after acceptance to CYA Registration Fee	\$300
Due April 1 to CYA	<u>\$2,600</u>
Total CYA fees	\$2,900

In late April you will be notified by the Bloomington Bursar via e-mail that your statement is available for viewing and printing from the web through OneStart. Your prepayment and any IUB financial aid will be reflected as credits there. Stafford loans will be disbursed in two payments. Please contact the Office of Financial Assistance with any questions concerning loan disbursement.

The Overseas Study Fee (co-spons) is an unremittable portion of IU tuition, which cannot be waived if you are to receive IU credit. It is used to retire IU's construction bonds and is not retained by Overseas Study. The Overseas Study Service fee underwrites the activities of the Office of Overseas Study.

It is your responsibility to send your payment to CYA. IU will not send payments to CYA on behalf of students.

III. On-site Costs

In addition to the fees paid to IU and CYA, you will need \$25-40 per day in Greece for food, and \$100-200 per week for personal expenses, entertainment, and vacation travel.

IU Refund Policy

Once paid, the \$200 IU Service fee is non-refundable. The Overseas Study fee is refunded on a cost-recoverable basis only.
