**III. Other Program Costs**

In addition to the fees paid to IU and CIC, it is estimated you will need about \$675 for airfare from Miami, and between \$500-\$700 personal expenses and vacation travel. These latter sums are discretionary and can vary significantly from one student to another depending on your lifestyle and budget.
