

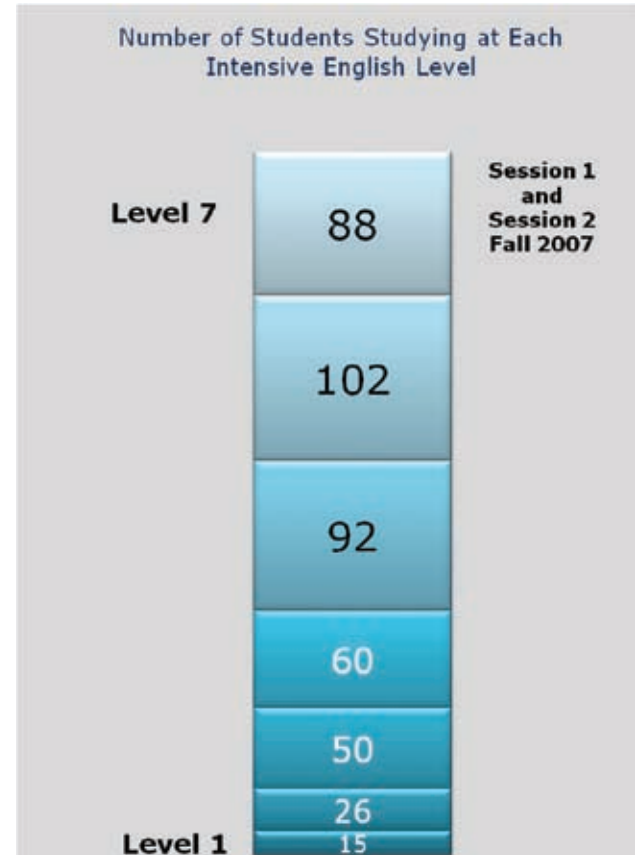
INTENSIVE ENGLISH PROGRAM

The Intensive English Program (IEP) provides training in the English language for individuals who are preparing to meet the English language qualifications to enter U.S. degree programs or indeed anyone who wishes to improve their spoken and written English. A part of the IU Bloomington Department of Second Language Studies, the IEP offers six seven-week sessions a year. Each session provides training, from the most basic for individuals with no English language proficiency to jumpstart classes for individuals brushing up their skills before entering the MBA program. Students enter university programs all over the U.S.; about a quarter continue with degree work at IU.



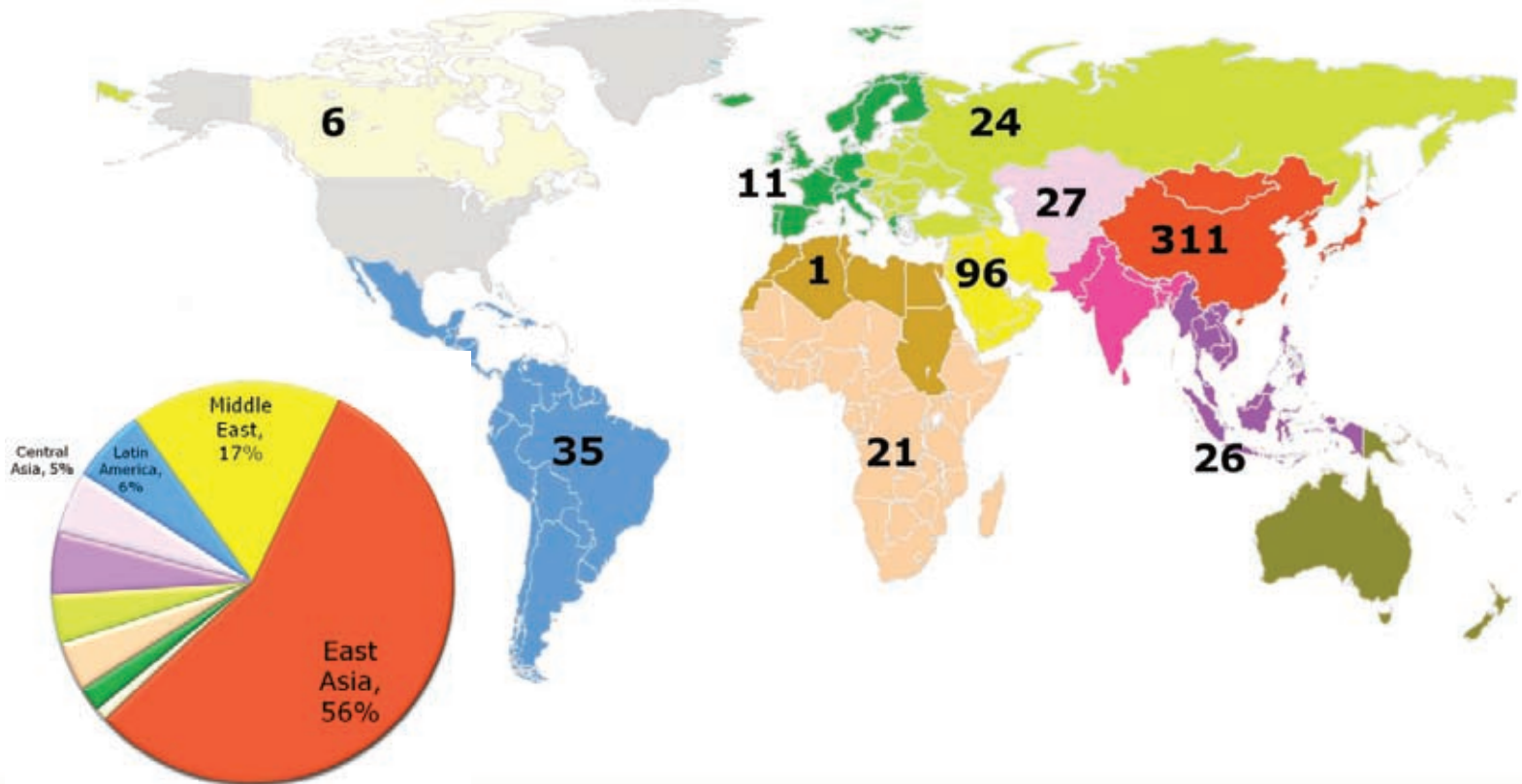
INTENSIVE ENGLISH PROGRAM - COMPETENCY LEVELS

The Intensive English Program offers six seven-week sessions a year. Each session offers courses at seven levels. Students with no English language skills begin at Level 1. Most students who complete Level 6 can qualify for undergraduate university work. Level 7 is available for students who need higher levels of proficiency.
