Old Church Slavonic Inflection Exercise

I. On the first page of the texts in the Elkina text (pg. 194), identify all words with inflectional paradigms; state the name of each such word's paradigm as used by Lunt and/or Elkina; give the dictionary form for each such word (e.g. nom. sing. for nouns, infinitive or basic stem for verbs).

II. For each of the following verb stems (listed in Lunt basic form notation), do these steps:

- Give both the Lunt and Elkina classifications.
- Give the 1st pers. sing., 3rd pers. sing., and 3rd pers. plural of the Present, Imperfect, and Productive Aorist tenses; give the Infinitive and Supine.
- For non-suffixed verbs, give the 1st and 3rd pers. sing. root and s-aorist.
- Give the 2nd pers. sing. and plur. imperatives.
- Give the 4 participial forms (present active and passive, past active and passive) in both masc. nom. sing. and fem. nom. sing.
