

For each of the following items in Latin **transliteration**:

1. Practice writing in Cyrillic.
2. Provide a transcription of the probable phonetics plus a *phonemic* transcription.
(For the phonetics, assume allophonic palatalization of diffuse consonants (labials and dentals), and assume the existence of [ń], [ř], [l̥], rather than [nj], [rj], and [lj]. In the case of *jers*, indicate which are strong and which are weak; also point out *tense jers*).
3. Show syllabic boundaries.
4. Indicate whether jers are strong or weak.
