The departments of Music and Anthropology at Kenyon College invite applications for a joint interdisciplinary tenure-track position at the assistant professor level in ethnomusicology with a focus on Asia. Generously supported by the Luce Fund for Asian Studies, this position in Asian Music and Culture includes one year of start-up or program funding. The candidate's expertise may be in East, Southeast, or Central Asia. The candidate's primary appointment will be in the Music Department, where he or she will teach an introductory course in ethnomusicology as well as other courses about Asian music and performance. In addition, he or she must be able to teach an Introduction to Cultural Anthropology course. An ability to teach gamelan ensemble is also desired, as the Music Department owns its own gamelan. Qualifications include a Ph.D. in ethnomusicology and a demonstrated commitment to teaching. A master's degree or significant course work in anthropology is also a plus.

Kenyon College is located on an idyllic campus in rural central Ohio (about 50 miles northeast of Columbus), enrolls approximately 1500 students, and is ranked in the top tier of national liberal arts colleges.
