Ability to contribute courses to our Latin American Studies or other area studies programs highly desirable. Performance experience and ability to direct or co-direct an ensemble preferred. Teaching will include introductory survey courses, an intermediate ethnomusicological methods course, and upper-level seminars in the candidate's areas of interest; plus some introductory music theory. Completed Ph. D. strongly preferred; some teaching experience required.
