

Federal Direct GradPLUS Request 2009–2010 Academic Year

Application Process:

- You must have a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) completed for the 2009-2010 academic year in order to be eligible for a Federal Direct GradPLUS Loan. The FAFSA is available at www.fafsa.ed.gov.
- You need to complete the loan application below to apply for a Federal Direct GradPLUS Loan for graduate students. Completing the form is required each time you borrow funds under the GradPLUS Loan program.
- Your information will be submitted to the U.S. Department of Education (USDE) once it has been received. The USDE will then run a credit check to determine your loan eligibility.
- First time borrowers, under the Federal GradPLUS Loan program, will be notified to complete their Master Promissory Note (MPN) before any funds may be disbursed to their Bursar account.
- Any remaining credit balance after all IU charges have been paid will be issued directly to you as a refund.
