Francesc Parcerisas is a renowned Catalan poet, translator and professor in the Department of Translation and Interpretation at the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona. His books of poetry include, among others, *Vint poemes civils* (1967), *Homes que es banyen* (1970), *L'edat d'or* (1983), *Natura morta amb nens* (2000), *Dos dies més de sud* (2006) and *Seixanta-un poemes* (2014). He is also the author of various essays on translation and of the diary *La primavera a Pequín* (2013). He is the recipient of most of the major literary awards in Catalonia, including *Carles Riba* (1966), *Joan Alcover* (1975), *Crítica de poesia catalana* (1983), *Lletra d'Or* (1991) and *Llibreter de narrativa* (2013). He has translated into Catalan Ezra Pound, F. Scott Fitzgerald, Seamus Heaney, and J.R.R. Tolkiens' *The Hobbit* and *The Lord of the Rings* trilogy, among many others.
