

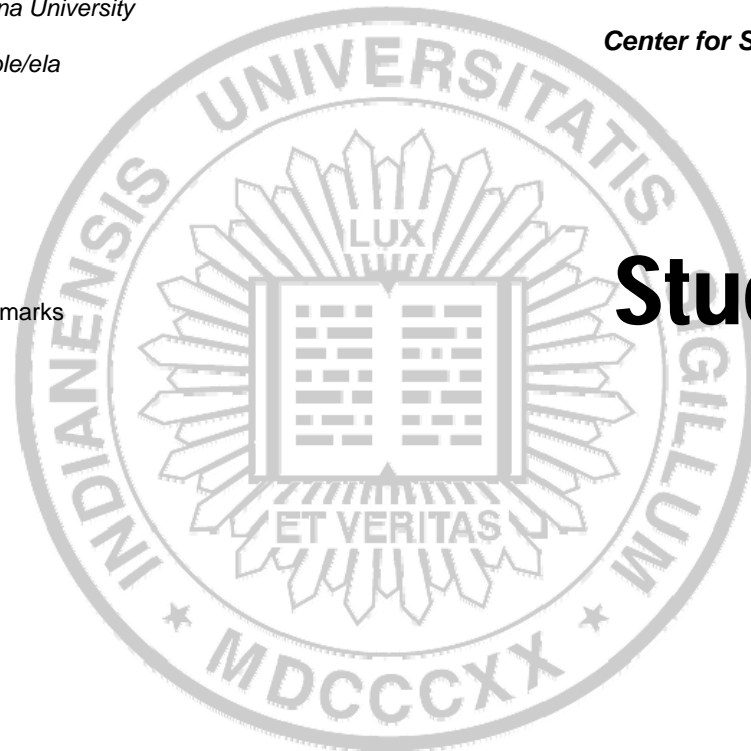

Installation Instructions



Installation

For more installation details, please see the file *Install.html* on your CD.

Minimum system requirements:

Windows

- Windows 98/ME/NT4/2000/XP
- 128 MB RAM minimum
- 400 MB hard disk space

Macintosh

- Mac OS X 10.2.3 or later
- 256 MB RAM minimum
- 400 MB hard disk space

Linux

- Linux x86 (Red Hat 7.2, 7.3, 8.0, 9.0, or equivalent)
- 128 MB RAM minimum
- 500 MB hard disk space

Starting the Installer

Windows: If Autoplay is enabled, the Maple installation will begin

automatically. If you have disabled Autoplay, you can start the installer by clicking *D:\windows\Disk1\InstData\WinstallMaple11.exe* (where D is the CD-ROM drive with the Maple CD).

Macintosh: After inserting the CD double-click the *MAPLE 11* icon and then double-click the *Maple 11 installer* icon.

Linux: Once the CD drive is mounted and the CD is inserted, run the installer with the command *\$CDPATH/installMapleLinuxSU*. Here *\$CDPATH* is the path to your CD drive, for example */mnt/cdrom*.

After this point differences between the installations on different platforms are minor. The installer will prompt you to ask for your preferences and install Maple.

Activating your license

You must activate your installation to obtain the license file and run Maple. For activation **you need the purchase code located on the CD sleeve**. You can activate after the installation with the following steps.

1. Connect to the Internet.
2. Start Standard Worksheet Maple 11.
3. When prompted to activate, click *Activate*.
4. Enter your purchase code from the CD sleeve.
5. Complete the online form and click *Next*.

This purchase code is valid for one installation. It will not work on multiple machines.
