Installation Instructions



Indiana University

This CD can be installed on up to two computers that are used by a single user. Once SPSS has been installed and authorized, the authorization code is no longer valid and the CD cannot be used for further installations.

If you need to install SPSS on additional computers, you will need to purchase another copy of the program.

This program is an annual lease. The expiration date is printed on the CD sleeve. Once the program expires, and you wish to continue to use SPSS, you will need to purchase a new CD, uninstall the old SPSS, and install the new one. To uninstall the old SPSS, from the Start menu choose *Setting* and *Control Panel*, and double-click *Add/Remove Programs*.

Installation

Minimum system requirements:

- Windows XP or 2000 SP3
- Pentium or Pentium-class CPU
- 256 MB RAM minimum
- 400 MB hard disk space
- CD-ROM drive
- SVGA (800x600 resolution)
- Network adapter (recommended)

Log in to your computer with administrator privileges and verify that the system date is correct.

Insert the CD into the CD-ROM drive to invoke Autoplay. If it does

not start, choose *Run* from the *Start* menu and type `D:\setup.exe` (replace D with the appropriate drive location).

Be sure to select *Single-user License* as the license type. After installation, launch the *License Authorization Wizard* to obtain a license from SPSS Inc. Otherwise, SPSS will not be fully functional after a 14-day trial period. Authorization can be done by phone, email, or through an internet connection.
