T540 SPECIAL PROJECT IN TELECOMMUNICATIONS

INTRODUCTION

The Telecommunications faculty provides a limited number of “Special Project” opportunities for graduate students. Credit (1-3) will be given for the satisfactory completion of student-initiated projects. Students may propose independent study projects in either production or non-production areas. Limitations on our financial and supervisory resources make it unlikely that production proposals other than those which can be related to a group project initiated by the Department of Telecommunications or Radio-Television Services can be authorized.

It is expected that all projects undertaken will be completed in the semester of registration. Supervisors have been directed to refuse requests for extension of time in all but the most severe hardship cases.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Any student who wishes to propose an individual project in T540 should proceed in the manner described below:

1. Pick up application form from the Graduate Program Administrator or request it electronically (email theodor@indiana.edu) or print a copy from the website (http://www.indiana.edu/~telecom/graduate_courses.html).
2. Develop a detailed proposal.
3. Seek approval of the faculty advisor whose field of competence qualify him/her to direct the proposed study.
4. The chair of the student’s Advisory Committee (or the student’s Academic Advisor) must then approve the proposal.
5. Submit the proposal to the Director of Graduate Studies.
6. The application process should be completed before registration. Registration requires online authorization. Once the proposal is approved, an online permission will be entered.
