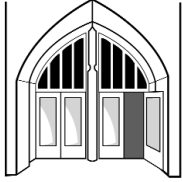

Dear University Club Member,

The University Club has a long tradition of fostering collegiality among its members and the campus community. Three years ago we launched an important effort to take that tradition a step further and help one or more Indiana University students by establishing a unique scholarship. Our goal for Year Two was to reach the \$10,000 mark for the endowment which guarantees that the fund will exist in perpetuity. Thanks to your generous support, we made that goal and there will always be a University Club Scholarship. We recognize and extend our gratitude to Ruth Albright for all her dedication and hard work in the establishment and success of the University Club Scholarship program.

We are again asking for your support as we seek to continue the growth of the University Club Scholarship. Your support will enable us to increase the value of the Scholarship to each recipient and/or allow us to reward scholarships to additional students. The selection committee of University Club officers and board members will determine the number and value of the scholarships and also select the recipients.

Donors may designate whether they want their gifts used for a current-year scholarship or used exclusively to increase the endowment. Since the endowment is fully funded, the scholarship(s) will be paid from earnings of the endowment fund. The amount of the scholarship and the number of students who can be rewarded will increase over time as we are able to increase the amount of the endowment.

Any donation of \$100 or more is eligible to receive a beautiful 18 X 26 inch photo reproduction of the T.C. Steele scene of Brown County that hangs on the west wall of the Presidents Room.

Contributions may be tax-deductible on federal tax returns and may also be eligible for the Indiana College Credit on state tax returns, depending on your personal circumstances. Information is available from the IU Foundation for making gifts of stock, appreciated assets, life insurance, or life income gift plans. Assistance with estate planning and tax benefits to you can be provided.
