Provider Network	Anthem Blue Access (Indiana)
Medical Annual Deductible	\$900 individual (\$2,700 family) (Applies to all services except wellness, emergency, prescriptions, mental health, and transplant benefits)
Medical Out-of-Pocket Maximum	\$2,400 individual (\$6,700 family) then there is no medical copay. (Deductibles and copays apply to the maximum except prescriptions and Mental Health/Chemical Dependency services)
Medical Copay	10% after deductible.
Preventive Services - including one routine or diabetic eye exam per year	Covered subject to copay. (not subject to deductible)
Outpatient Prescriptions (Anthem Prescription Retail Network and NextRx Mail Order Pharmacy)	<p>Retail copays: \$8 generic, \$20 low-cost brand (up to \$65) and \$40 high-cost brand (\$65 or more).</p> <p>Mail Order copays: \$20 generic, \$45 low-cost brand (up to \$65) and \$90 high-cost brand (\$65 or more).</p>
Mental Health	Mental Health services are provided through IU Psychiatric Management (IUPM) and require prior authorization.
Dental	No coverage for dental services.
