This report provides semester-to-semester student flow (i.e., persistence and graduation) tables for six of your campus' full-time beginner cohorts (2001-2006) and abbreviated snapshots of student flow for various subgroups (e.g., gender, race, age) within each full-time beginner cohort. Unlike the fall-to-fall retention rates or 150% graduation rates provided to external audiences, student flow tables report re-enrollment during the spring semester and they include degrees conferred beyond 150% (for certificate and associate's degrees). Following the policy of official university reporting, the student flow tables credit your campus with the persistence and graduation of members of your full-time beginner cohorts who transfer to another IU campus. Due to minor differences in the methodology for producing this report, however, information will differ slightly from that presented in official university reports.
